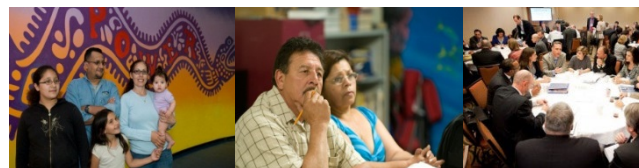


A young girl attends a school in Tijuana that supports students with special needs. The school is a grantee of two sister foundations in the San Diego/Tijuana area.
